Key responsibilities and accountabilities include:

- Evaluating the clinical and economic profiles of medical products of interest, as well as current and future competitors
- Analyzing diseases and treatment landscapes for identifying potential investment opportunities in therapeutic areas of interest
- Gather, analyze and make recommendations to the Investment team based on information from scientific literature, industry databases, medical conference presentations, primary research and secondary research reports and deal meeting materials (presentations and pitch books)
- Creating deal sourcing material (opportunity profiles, drug reviews, biographical materials)
- Preparing preliminary valuations for investment opportunities
